

Vontier Corporation Waste Management Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Waste Management Policy is to establish guidelines for the proper management of waste generated by the organization to promote environmental sustainability, comply with legal requirements, and ensure the safety and health of employees and the community. This policy is in support of our goal to divert at least 90% of manufacturing facility waste from landfills by the end of 2030.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all employees, contractors, and visitors at all facilities operated by the organization.

3. Policy Statement

The organization is committed to minimizing waste generation and managing waste in an environmentally responsible manner. This includes reducing, reusing, recycling, and disposing of waste in accordance with regulatory requirements and best practices.

4. Responsibilities

Management: Ensure compliance with this policy, allocate resources for waste management, and provide training to employees.

Employees: Follow waste management procedures, participate in waste reduction initiatives, and report any waste management issues.

Waste Management Team: Oversee waste management activities, conduct regular audits, and provide recommendations for improvement.
